Objectives

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) aims to establish a spirit of cooperation in pursuing education, training and mobility opportunities between Mohawk College and SEDUC by providing opportunities for language studies ~~and academic studies~~ in order to foster the development of both parties through collaborative endeavours.

The nature of the collaboration

Both institutions shall jointly collaborate in activities (both virtually and in-person) which will include, but will not be limited to:

1. Promote and facilitate the possibility for students and members of society from Campeche, Mexico to further their education and improve their English skills through Mohawk Colleges’ English for Academic Purposes program (EAP) and summer language camp.

2. Maintain regular communication between the institutions to ensure activities are developed.
3. Gain further mutual understanding of each institution and promote an on-going relationship and level of cooperation in areas of knowledge exchange, education and teaching methodologies and education leadership.

For clarity, once the partners have decided on the terms for any education, training or mobility opportunities, the parties will negotiate a binding agreement outlining those terms.

Terms of the agreement

This MOU will become effective on the first day of signing and remain in place for a period of five years. Any amendment may be proposed through mutual consent and through obtaining the signatures of the undersigned below (or their nominated representative) on an Appendix attached to this MOU.

Either party may terminate this MOU for convenience and without cause, upon sixty (60) calendar days' written notice to the other party.

Either party may terminate this MOU if the other party commits a material breach of the terms of this MOU, and such breach is not remedied to the reasonable satisfaction of that party within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of written notice describing the particulars of the breach.

This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the applicable federal law of Canada.

In the event of any dispute between them with respect to this MOU, the parties will attempt to resolve the dispute by good faith negotiation for a period of not less than ten (10) business days.

This MOU is a statement of intent of the parties to collaborate through coordination of each party's own efforts, and is not legally binding upon the parties. It does not create legal or contractual rights or obligations.

The parties are and shall remain independent entities and nothing herein shall be construed to create a partnership, agency, joint venture, or teaming MOU between the parties. Neither party has the authority to represent the other party as to any matters, except as expressly authorized in this MOU.

This MOU is in English and a copy will be held by each party.
